

AT THE GAME:

- 1. Wear your uniform and have your indicator and brush. Get all protective gear on. Shin guards, chest protector, mask.
- 2. Be on time that means 10-15 minutes BEFORE game time.
 - Introduce yourself to the coaches. Shake their hand.
 - Find and adjust all your equipment.
 - Find your game Coordinator (they sign your timesheet) NOT A COACH.
- 3. Know the RULES refresh yourself on your local rules from NLLB.ORG



4. Be Professional

- Be respectful at all times. Sarcasm and snark are not allowed.
- Be in charge of the game, move it along, watch the time limit.
- No cell phones out during a game, unless you are checking time between inning (1 minute).
- No "goofing off" in between innings
- 5. Get your time sheet signed and send a picture to your cooridnator in RIGHT AFTER THE GAME
 - No Time sheet, no pay

OVERALL


- This is your JOB. You are the only person the field being paid. Be on time. Take it seriously and do your best.
- Keep track of your schedule. If you sign up for a game, put it on your phone's calendar. Make sure you look every day to see if you signed up for a game.



OVERALL

- DO NOT BE LATE. If you are late multiple times, your games will be taken away. If you show up after I've found a replacement, you will not be paid.
- DO NOT "NO SHOW"
 - Being tired, or too busy. Is not an excuse.
 - "I didn't get a notification" is not an excuse.
 - TEXT your umpire coordinator if your plans change. Unless you are ill or there is an emergency, we appreciate 24 hour notice.
 - If you no-show more than once, you are removed from available umpire list

Scheduling



- 1. The Umpire Schedulers will contact you to sign up for game.
- 2. Each scheduler will have their own procedures. Some use SignupGenius, some use Excel or Google Sheets.
- 3. Goal work 5 games from April October. You must work 5 games to advance to higher umpire level.
- 4. You should get texts and emails from our new system TeamSideline.

 Please confirm we have the umpire's cell phone and email address, as well as the parent's.

Game Reschedules

- 1. Games are rescheduled as soon as possible, and the umpire follows the rescheduled game.
- 2. You should be contracted by Email or Text. Please confirm we have the umpire's cell phone and email address, as well as the parent's.
- 3. If your umpire cannot make the rescheduled game, contact your coordinator ASAP! If you do not show up for a game, that is a "No Show".
- 4. If you do not see a reschedule notice, contact your coordinator.

- > What to bring to a game:
 - 1. Handout of local rules and penalties
 - 2. Uniform (can have coat over in cold weather)
 - 3. Hat (if you need to keep mask on)
 - 4. Indicator
 - 5. Brush
 - 6. Access to the Little League Rule Book
 - 7. Water Bottle





- □ NLL pays after a complete month. Check will come by mail, normally 2 weeks after the month end
- □ Pay comes in a plain white envelope. "PAYMENT ENCLOSED"
- ☐ Turn in your timesheets on time, to get paid on time. No time sheet no pay.
- □ Please cash checks as soon as possible. Do not wait until I start sending harassing emails.
- If you see an issue with your check, contact your coordinator.
- ☐ If you lose a check, we will confirm it was delivered, and you will be charged the cancellation fee for re-issuing.
